GAS IS NOW AVAILABLE IN VAL MARIE. Located at the corner of Hwys 4 and 18 ? Look for the large white fuel tank in an open field. B&A FUEL STATION ? Gas & Clear and dyed Diesel ? 24-hr accessible card lock. Unattended. The card lock will accept VISA, MasterCard, and ARI Fleet Management Cards. Process your card using the machine which is located in the small shed beside the tanks. To get a receipt, return to the machine and reinsert your card.

Gas is also available at Cadillac, Mankota (key lock), Bracken, and Climax.
